A Thought from Mark...

A rabbi was teaching his students a lesson on preparing for death and on repentance. One of the students asked, "Rabbi, when should a man repent?" The rabbi responded, "Repent a day before your death." His students were confused. "How can a man know the day of his death?" they asked. His answer: "He cannot, and since he may die tomorrow, it is all the more necessary for him to repent today."

Jesus came preaching repentance (Matthew 4:17; Luke 13:3, 5). His disciples followed suit (Acts 2:38; 3:19; 8:22). The Lord also preached preparedness – always being alert and ready. Although we may not know the day of our death, we must be ready for it – prepared.

There is a passage that runs between 2 Corinthians 5 and 6 that is worthy of attention today. Here is it:

For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain. For he says, In a favorable time I listened to you, and in a day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the favorable time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

Point #1 – In Christ we find spiritual safety before God do to His righteousness given to us.

Point #2 – It is possible, despite God's great riches toward us, to throw it all away and lose His grace we once enjoyed.

Point #3 – There is an urgency to salvation – it is not a thing to wait for another day to achieve or to secure. Now is the time, today is the day. Tomorrow may indeed be too late.

For the believer, who has once already called upon the Lord in obedient faith and received God's riches at Christ's expense, the manner of being ready is to repent. When we find we have sinned, we confess it and repent – and the blood of Jesus continues to continually cleanse us.

My fear is that some Christians feel (at least they behave as if) that they repented once before they were baptized, and that is a "one-time-covers-all" repentance. We don't have to be baptized every time we sin, so why repent repeatedly?

However, the clear counsel of Scripture is that repentance is a way of life for a disciple of Jesus, one whose heart is tender and whose ear is open to God's truth. Repentance is change – changing the way we think and act. That does not stop with initial gospel obedience. It is the way of Christ.

He is currently an administrator at Ohio Valley University in Vienna, WV.


