#### A Thought from Mark...

How hard would it be to be the great missionary / apostle Paul, and not get an answer to your earnest prayer? Three times Paul asked God for a removal of what was troubling him, his famous "thorn in the flesh." Each time, he received the same answer: "No. My grace is sufficient for you. My power is perfected in your weaknesses" (2 Corinthians 12:7-9).

That would be a tough thing to swallow. But it was an important step in Paul becoming who God called him to be. This is the stuff of Christian maturity. No one ever said it was going to be easy. Paul's conclusion? "For when I am weak, then I am strong" (12:10b).

Someone wrote these meaningful words:

I asked for strength that I might achieve;

He made me weak that I might obey.

I asked for health that I might do great things;

He gave me grace that I might do better things.

I asked for riches that I might be happy;

He gave me poverty that I might be wise.





#### Mark 16:1-11

When the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, so that they might go and anoint him. And very early on the first day of the week, when the sun had risen, they went to the tomb. And they were saying to one another, "Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance of the tomb?" And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled back—it was very large. And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed. And he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen; he is not here. See the place where they laid him. But go, tell his disciples and Peter that he is going before you to Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you." And they went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had seized them, and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

Now when he rose early on the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons. She went and told those who had been with him, as they mourned and wept. But when they heard that he was alive and had been seen by her, they would not believe it.
