A Thought from Mark...

Do you ever worry about worrying? Is worry a sin? Is it wrong sometimes but ok others? Is it not a big deal at all? Does this topic worry you?

Jesus, as you remember, addressed this theme in His great sermon – Matthew chapter 6:25-34. Meditate on the powerful, divine wisdom in these words:

Therefore, I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tumorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

In this section of Jesus' wonderful message, did you notice that three times he repeats the phrase "Do not be anxious" (or "Don't worry) – at the beginning (vs. 25), in the middle (vs. 31), and at the end (vs. 34). This tells us what this part of the sermon is about. Don't worry!

Jesus gives several reasons not to worry for disciples, which fill out the sermon and which you can pull out on your own. The root problem of worry seems to be lack of trust in God – that is, acting like an unbeliever or even a believer in false gods.

The idolaters of Jesus' day were in a constant state of worry, because they were like orphaned children who had no one to look out for them. They were scared of what was around every corner to get them. God's children have a benevolent and attentive and caring Father, always willing to hear their cries and minister to their needs. It is a sin to act as if God doesn't care and is unwilling to help. This is the issue.

There may indeed be times when we are concerned, even worried. The key is worrying in faith, being anxious but remaining convinced of the truth that our God is able and our God cares. He is a good Father.

This being true, we turn our anxieties into prayers, and we leave them there. This is the essence of Godly faith. So, worry if you must, but not as those who have no hope!


