A Thought from Mark...

Do you think enough about God's power at work in you? I doubt we do so enough. Paul uses a wonderful phrase in Colossians 1:27 – "Christ in you, the hope of glory." Earlier in the chapter, he wishes this for the people of Colossae – "May you be strengthened with all power, according to his glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy..." – verse 11. Then in verses 15-20 we get what many call "the great Christ-hymn," including the description of Jesus as "the firstborn from the dead." There is the key to the power – He is risen. Christ is risen from the dead. We were raised with Christ. God is at work in us with great power.

The great preacher of former days, Charles Spurgeon, said this:

"The very same power which raised Christ is waiting to raise the drunkard from his drunkenness, to raise the thief from his dishonesty, to raise the Pharisee from his self-righteousness, to raise the Sadducee from his unbelief."

What power is referred to here, waiting to do all these great things in people? The power of God. God raised Jesus from the dead. God gave us hope in Christ. Christ in you, the hope of glory!

It is a hope for here, and a hope for then. A hope for now, and a hope for later. A hope for time, and a hope for eternity. God's power at work...in Christ...and in us. Praise God from whom all blessings flow, praise Him all creatures here below, praise Him above ye heavenly host, praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost!




