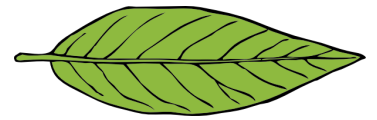

Unlike Matthew and Luke,
Mark shortens the account
of Jesus' temptation, but
he adds a bit about wild
beasts being with him. He



then moves to the arrest of John the Baptist and Jesus' preach-
ing in Galilee. His message is a simple one, "The time has
come. The kingdom, the reign of God is at hand." He concludes
with a simple appeal for repentance and faith in the gospel,
the good news.

Mark then records Jesus call of the first four of his disciples, all
fishermen, brothers Peter and Andrew and brother, James and
John. He again has a simple appeal, "Follow Me, and I will
make you fishers of men.

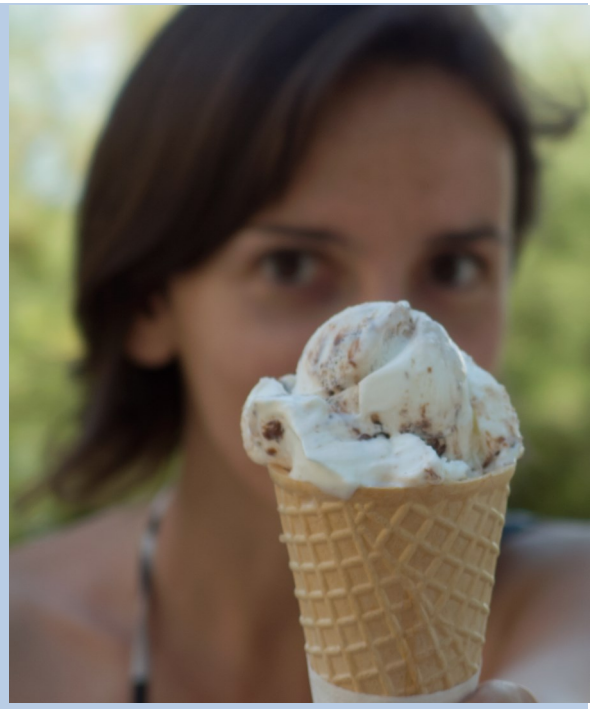
We learn from John's gospel that this was not the first time he
had met these men. They all had likely been disciples of John,
had met Jesus, and had heard him preach. It was not quite as
abrupt as one might assume if he had read only Mark.

The call to repent, to believe the gospel, and to be fishers of
men is on that goes out to us today as well.

Lord, grant us the courage to be your disciples and to share
the gospel with our world.
