

The God On Your Side

Don't you just love a little friendly competition? There's something about being a part of a team that makes you excited to root for "us" and root against "them." With people and with God, we're often quick to see others like our enemies, but God invites us to see things differently.

We love to think in "us or them" ways, don't we? It's easy to see the world through the lens of "good or evil," "heroes or villains," and "us or them." We see the world in Marvel vs DC, coffee vs tea, Steelers vs Browns, Gryffindor vs Hufflepuff, Chik Fil A vs Popeyes (perhaps the greatest indicator that our society is in trouble HAHA). But it has been God, in fact, that has been trying to invite mankind to something greater from the beginning.

It starts with the very first humans, Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve chose to disobey God because they *didn't believe God was on their side*. They wondered whether God was unfair or holding out on them, so they disobeyed, thinking they knew better. Adam and Eve even turned against each other too, blaming each other for what they'd both decided to do.
