Hallelujah

Bible Thought: After these things I heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God." (Revelation 19:1 NAU)

Hallelujah is really a Hebrew word transliterated into English. It is literally "Praise Yahweh" or "Praise the LORD." It really appears as "Praise the LORD" or the parallel "Praise Him" twelve times in Psalm 148.

Yahweh, the LORD, is to be praised by heavens, the angels, the sun, moon, and stars, which were all created by Him. The author goes on to say that He is to be praised by the earth, sea monsters, the depths of the earth, fire and hail, snow and clouds, stormy winds, mountains and hills, fruit trees and cedars, beasts and cattle, and creeping things and winged fowl. Again, they are all created by Him and owe their existence to Him.

Likewise, the LORD owed praise by all peoples: kings of the earth and all peoples; princes and judges; young men and virgins; old men and children.

The psalm is a call for all of us to praise God.
