36th Street Church of Christ (private Group) This week marks a year since I moved into the house I had closed on the month before (the weekend I 'tried-out' at 36th Street) to live near my two oldest and first grandchild, moved into my now repainted office while meeting many at a welcome reception, preached my first lesson as your associate minister, and then turned 50. What a week!

A lot has happened in my life in that year as I got to know the area, expanded my base of friends, moved my father-in-law and youngest here, marked difficult 'firsts' (and some 'seconds') after my wife's passing, and got engaged to a widow, who had worshiped with 36th Street for a third of its existence.

In my year here, our numbers have mostly rebounded since Covid, and we've conducted School Store and Clothing giveaways, began Centennial and Widows Walk ministries, and taken on big projects like the demolition of the white house and the imminent installation of an electronic sign. Also, because OVU closed late last year, I stepped up as your ninth 'located' minister in the 98year history of the 36th Street Church of Christ (Pleasant Avenue and 34th Street before that) when the Mosses left to be near family this past spring.

I have come to appreciate this church's deep mark for Christ's kingdom that it has made in the MOV and around the world and its commitment to furthering the truth of the gospel in an increasingly antagonistic culture. And, though the battlelines have changed over the decades, I am encouraged by our leaders' and the congregation's determination to fight, so Jesus' light at 36th Street may continue to shine ever brighter for years to come.

To do this, we must "*press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.*" This is not a time for Christians to retire but to roll up our sleeves. Not a time to shrink back but step forward. A time of remembering, yes, but also of striving ahead.
