by Doug Kashorek Perhaps you've been around someone who has an excuse for everything: "the sun was in my eyes," "if I wasn't so tired ...," or "that's not the way we used to do it." I think I must have used that last one when helping my kids

Or, what about a church that always has a reason why it doesn't reach out? "God provides the increase." So, is it His fault that the church isn't growing (1 Corinthians 3:6) or have we given up planting and watering? "No one is really interested in the gospel anymore. There are too many distractions." Has the world really grown so strong that it's finally overpowered Jesus' church that He promised even the gates of Hades could not prevail against (Matthew 16:18)?

We live in an age of disassociation and have carved out safe spaces amidst a chaotic culture. Then we believe our circumstances justify our excuse to live a mediocre Christian existence. Much like a gym membership, we have separated out being a Christian from our real lives and relegated devotion to God to a couple of hour time slots throughout the week-well, unless we have good enough excuse not to attend. In this way, we avoid standing out or clashing with our secular or denominational neighbors.

Faith becomes how much knowledge we can soak in, not what that knowledge propels us to do. Application is not safe ... and not easy to live! The first Christians, however, who had been cut to the heart, "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (Acts 2:42). If ever a generation had an excuse to make excuses, these 1st century followers did as they endured ostracization, persecution, and death. Yet, by their devotion they lived out their faith and trusted that God had all power and was in control.

So we, in the 21st century, must live out our faith by being devoted to all that God has commanded us to do, trusting that He's with us through it all.
