### **We Will Sing and Praise Your Power!**

The last verse of last Sunday evening's psalm ended this way: *"Be exalted, O LORD, in your strength! We will sing and praise your power."* Now ... that's right and fitting for YHWH, Almighty God, but should we sing and praise Jesus' power?

*Ego Eimi*—I AM—the very name that Almighty God gave to Moses at the burning bush so he could tell the Israelites who had sent him (Exodus 3:14). It is how Jesus revealed Himself to the sinful woman at the Samaritan well. It's the name He used for Himself with *"the Jews who had believed him"* in this same chapter (v58). It's the two words uttered about Himself in the garden that made the mob who had come to arrest Him fall to the ground (John 18:6).

It's one of Jesus' seven declarations about Himself made in John, the others being *"Ego Eimi ... the bread of life (6:35), the door (10:7), the good shepherd (v11-14), the resurrection and the life (11:25), the way, the truth, and the life (14:6), the true vine (15:1), and ...*

*"Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life'"* John 8:12.

So ... Jesus is not saying He has the light like an Old Testament prophet or like we who are simply jars of clay who hold the treasure of the gospel (2 Corinthians 4:7); no, He is declaring that He **IS** the light of the world. Each of us must ask, then: am I following the light or walking in the dark?

But then, Almighty God in the flesh turns this around to the jars of clay following Him and says, *"You are the light of the world. ... let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven"* Matthew 5:14-16. We bear His light.

Even the smallest of flames shines brighter the darker that this world grows. And, that's worth singing and praising Him for!

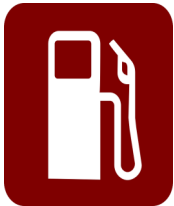

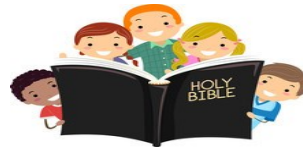
