What Things?

It must have been very confusing for Jesus' followers on the day He rose from the dead. Though He had told them multiple times what must happen to Him, no one seemed to expect it, nor without the Holy Spirit poured out upon them for another seven weeks could they truly comprehend this pivotal moment in human history.

And yet, on this defining day when death was overcome and a way was made through the Way to the Father, Jesus revealed His resurrected self to ... women—who could neither own property nor testify in a court of law! Two of His inner circle, who would be instrumental in the spread of the gospel in those crucial first decades, were left examining the empty tomb and marveling at what had happened while Jesus *“that very day”* spent hours with two minor followers who had only secondhand knowledge and rumors as they walked to Emmaus.

That may have been precisely *why* Jesus spent His first resurrected day with them. Kept from recognizing Him until they broke bread later that day, Cleopas and the other discussed the events of the past several days and confusing news that those women had brought them. At this monumental time, when He had defeated the one who had held the power of death and freed mankind from the fear of death (Hebrews 2:14-15) gripping us since we were barred from the Tree of Life (Genesis 3:24, Romans 5:12), Jesus listened and then asked, *“What things?”*

How the newly-crowned King of Kings through whom all things had been made (John 1:3) who had just been given all authority in heaven and on earth (Matthew 28:18) must have been bursting with the completion of the *“good news of great joy.”* But instead, He *“interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself”* Luke 24:27. What a study that must have been! No wonder their hearts burned within them!

And thus, we who know His resurrection have a model for winning souls. We ask seekers a simple question and then reveal to them the things concerning Jesus.
