Are You Ready for 36th Street's 100th?

When we began to plan for the centennial in November 2021, thirty months seemed so far away. Now, as January ends, we are just three months away from the festivities of our monthlong celebration in May 2024 when many who have worshiped with us over the years will visit! We'll have speakers from our past—voices still with us and those who've gone home with the Lord—who will take up topics ... and technologies from the past ten decades.

Soon, the magazine-style Centennial Book, chock-full of pictures and stories chronicling our 100-year journey as the first church of Christ in Vienna, will go to the printers. Have you seen the original hand-written paper about the \$1,848.07 little white church building set upon a \$400 lot? Or a picture of 383 people here on the Sunday of our 75th in 1999? Only 200 copies will be made, so reserve one today!

Huge, however, will be the final weekend of May that will begin with 36th Street hosting a special Friday Night Sing, an event that three of our members began in the MOV, when we will honor our song leaders of the past. Saturday will be 100 years to the day of Pleasant Avenue's dedication on May 25, 1924 (after streets were numbered we became 34th Street and later with the new building in 1972 the 36th Street Church of Christ). And so, we will hold a Centennial Celebration Banquet with an amazing program at Grand Pointe that evening from 6-9 pm.

Only 150 tickets will go on sale for \$10 a piece (thank you to all who've driven the price of these down) for two months, from

February 11 to April 11 ... so plan on getting them early! A mailer to over 300 names of people all over the country who have been connected with 36th Street will go out soon. In it will be information about our May events as well as forms to order books and banquet tickets.

Come home to celebrate a century with us!

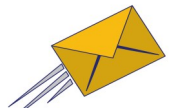
