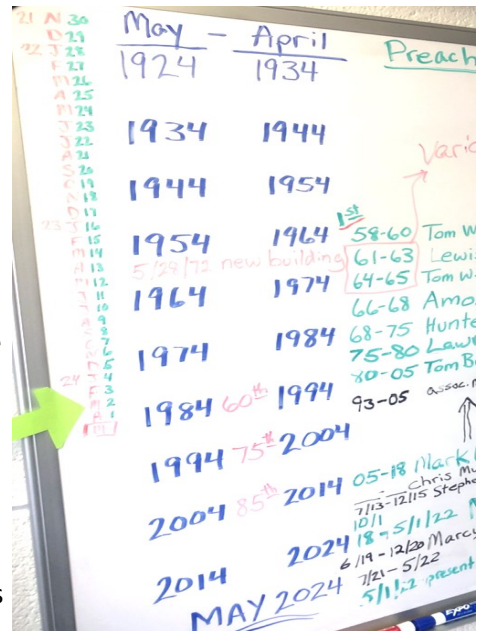

Though many thought November 2021 was too far away from our Centennial to think about, some with various skills came together as a committee to discuss and plan for that time we knew would come quicker than we could possibly realize. Thirty months from May 2024 was when we first began to gather pictures and stories of the past ... and now it's only a month and a half away. The Centennial book is at the printers! We thank everyone who contributed throughout the past two years to help us put this monumental work together. As of this writing, 116 pre-sales of the 200 that will be printed have been sold.

Our last Centennial Committee meeting will be on April 11, when the final preparations about speakers, the quilt, the special Friday Night Sing, the banquet, presentations, and time capsule will come together ... and we'll celebrate! Soon, those who recognize the powerful role that 36th Street has played in their lives will travel to us to celebrate with us. As of this writing, 181 of the 200 banquet tickets available have been bought.
