All the People Arose as One Man

The Levite cutting his dead concubine into twelve pieces and sending them to every tribe in Israel awakened God's people to how far they had drifted spiritually from their unity at Mt. Sinai when Moses had mediated a covenant relationship between God and His people. When the Levite explained what the Sodomites of Gibeah had done, Judges 20:8 says, "And all the people arose as one man, saying, 'None of us will go to his tent, and none of us will return to his house'" until they had righted what was wrong.

How long had it been since God's people had been united? Almost 200 years before 8:28 says, "the land had rest forty years in the days of Gideon," but only Gideon's 300 soldiers struck "the Midianites as one man" (6:16). Soon after, the Ephraimites took offense and "all Israel whored after" Gideon's ephod as an idol and snare (8:27). No, if God's people had unity in anything in the time of Judges, it was in doing "what was right in [their] own eyes" 21:25.

Circling like vultures around Joshua who was about to die, God's people expectantly awaited their inheritance in the Promised Land but were told to "choose this day whom you will serve" (Joshua 24:15) and that they had much conquering left to do—externally and internally to truly be united in their God as His people.

Perhaps we have to go all the way back to the second telling of the Law and the laying out of blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience before Moses died and Joshua was selected to lead God's people across the Jordan. At Jericho, under Joshua and the heavenly commander of the LORD's army, God's people **as one man** marched silently around the city for six days before waging war, not as the world does, but with a shout that truly had "divine power to destroy strongholds" 2 Corinthians 10:3-5.

That unity, of course, was short-lived as well, as Achan kept some devoted things for himself. What would it take for God's people today to arise as one man?
