## The Celebration of a Century is Here!

Thirty months of planning and hard work by so many has brought us to this point—a month-long celebration of 100 years of faithfully serving through the gospel from this little plot of land in Vienna! The first service was held by twenty-five charter members in January 1924, yet it wouldn't be until May 25, 1924, that they could dedicate the original building.

What a month we will have! We look forward to the many visitors who will come home in the next few weeks, and there is a schedule of activities and speakers available that outlines all that will go on. The last weekend of the month especially will have many special presentations. And of course, we still have copies of our centennial book that honors our past and hopes for our future.

In addition to new classes on Sundays and Wednesdays (more on those later), we'll have a special theme during our Sunday morning worship services to help us celebrate our centennial. Each speaker will approach the Parable of the Sower from Matthew 13 from a different angle: on how the soils, sowers, and seed has either changed or stayed the same over the past ten decades ... and finally how we can bear fruit a hundredfold for God's kingdom in the next century.

Our first two Sunday evenings will be different as we'll use new technology to present the old that had been used by preachers in our past. Perhaps you remember that before PowerPoint, preachers painted sermons on sheets and preached from them in smaller auditoriums without microphones. Bringing the first half of a sheet sermon (they can be very long) this evening, as well as our morning lesson, is our youngest speaker, Michael Rowand, who had been an intern at 36th Street during his OVU days from 2012-2015.

Michael currently is the preaching minister at the Westwood Church of Christ in McMinnville, TN, and has been married to MacKenzie for seven years. They are blessed with two daughters, Mariah and Marley. With fond memories of his time here, he says it's good to come home.
