## A Thought From Mark...

"We often confuse God's timing with ours. A country newspaper had been running a series of articles on the value of church attendance. One day, a letter to the editor was received in the newspaper office. It read, "Print this if you dare. I have been trying an experiment. I have a field of corn which I plowed on Sunday. I find that my harvest this October is just as great as any of my neighbors' who went to church on Sunday. So where was God all this time?"

The editor printed the letter, but added his reply at the bottom. "Your mistake was in thinking that God always settles his accounts in October." (Larry Kalajainěn)

When I read this little story I was reminded of the story Jesus told of the very successful farmer -

And he told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man produced plentifully, and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' And he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, ny grum and my goods. And I will say to my soul, Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.' But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God." (Luke 12:16-21)

Being rich towards God is about a lot more than money. We can be rich toward God with our time, or not. Our service, or not. Our involvement, or not. Our church attendance, or not. The man in Jesus' story was a fool because he thought he himself was the only one he had to answer to. I am afraid many people to-day feel the same. I have often heard the expression, "No Pain, No Gain!", and was never sure whether I agreed with it. Jerry made a decision to give up his nightly safari to create a happy and healthy relationship. To this day they are happily married and enjoying life with their children and grandchildren! Did it hurt a little to give up a lifelong practice? Yes, but was it worth it? Absolutely!

This same principle applies with any group of people. If a church is to grow spiritually and numerically there will be a time when discomfort is associated with success. Times have changed and what worked in the 1950s and 1960s will not work in the 2010s! One brilliant man noted, "Doing the same things over and over again while expecting different results is the definition of insanity!" Each of us must examine our own lives and be willing to step out of our "comfort zone" for the benefit of the church. There is no need to change biblical truths, moral standards, or loving relationships so that good results will happen, but there is a great need to examine our methods to be sure better results can be enjoyed. This is going to "sting" a little, but the results will be well worth the moments of discomfort!

So..."No Pain, No Gain!" does in truth state a much needed principle! As I go back to therapy on Tuesday, I will do so with a renewed spirit and determination to achieve my stated goals! And, remember, I am not a quitter so á little or a lot of pain will not deter me! Don't you be a quitter either!


