A Thought From Mark...

If I was asked to "Name one Scripture which, if fully understood and obeyed and restored to practice could make a huge difference in the church today" I might well respond with 2 Timothy 2:2.

"...and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also."

Why? Think about it with me.

We often talk about the importance of evangelism and sharing our faith with people who have never heard. And rightfully so! It is our great commission from Christ. But also, how important is it to pass on our faith to the next generation? To the younger Christian? To the newborn babe in Christ? To the less experienced?

As I observe churches and brothers and sisters in Christ, I often see them hamstrung by the fact that they are failing to do what Paul commands Timothy to do in the passage cited above.

For instance: how many Christians do you know whose children have either never adopted the faith or have fallen from it? How many are in church week after week without their kids – no matter how old those kids are?

How many young Christians – whether we define "young" in a chronological sense or more broadly in a "not been a Christian very long"-sense – fall away before they really get established and rooted and grounded in the truth?

Let me ask it another way: how often does it happen in a church where a person who has served in some meaningful capacity for a long period of time comes to a time in their life when they can no longer do so, and it is a great problem to find another to step up and take their place in their important and valued work? Why does that happen? Failure to live out 2 Timothy 2:2!

We make a big mistake if we apply this verse only to preachers and Bible class teachers. It is a spiritual principle of very broad application. We are supposed to be passing on our faith, which includes not just our personal commitment to Christ Jesus but also our areas of service and work in the Kingdom. If we do not train someone to do what we do, be what we are, know what we know – if we do NOT do that – then what happens either when we are no longer here or not able to do our thing? I think the answer to that question is clear and evident, is it not?

How important the obedience to just one verse of Scripture!!
