

# **Self-Perception**

When you picture yourself sharing the gospel, what do you see? Do you see yourself joyfully explaining what the Lord has done for you, and confidently directing questions to the Scriptures for answers? Or do you see yourself stuttering and unsure, afraid of making a mistake? The way we perceive ourselves performing in a certain situation has a direct effect on how we actually perform. It is very unlikely that we will even attempt something that we perceive we will do poorly.

Many Christians feel their ability to share the gospel is inadequate. The solution to a negative self-perception is to realize the power to save souls is in God's Word. We can confidently proclaim his Word because it is true, it is the only way to gain faith, and it is the power of God for salvation. Our boldness cannot be in our own abilities; it can only be in the fact that Jesus was the Son of God, that he died, and that God raised him from the dead.

But can we be truly humble at the same time we are trying to help someone see their need for salvation? Our boldness in the message cannot breed arrogance. In fact, if we present the message with an attitude of "we are better than you, so you need what we have," then we are not presenting the true message!

Peter shows us in 1 Peter 3:15 that confidence and humility are to work together when we share our faith. "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope you have," implies that we are to be confident in our hope, but the verse goes on to say, "but do this with gentleness and respect." We can humbly express to a lost soul the fact that we were once lost ourselves, and that <u>only</u> by the grace of God have we received the salvation in which we are so confident.

Picture yourself sharing your faith with a lost soul, and then go do it!
