
"caregiving"! This is demonstrated in unique ways, but have been given this assignment due to the failing health of a spouse, parent, child or even a close friend. I do not




In the immediate days following the workshop I hope to compile a list of those willing to temporarily serve so these precious caregivers can have a little time to themselves. What a gift of love this would be!
