## A Thought From Mark...

We have been having some painting done in our meeting place, as I am sure you have noticed. When I saw this story, I had to share it!

The man on the scaffold was painting the building when he dropped his paintbrush. As he leaned over the rail to watch his brush fall, he yelled, "Quack, quack, gobble, gobble."

Below a man walking under the scaffold was hit by the brush.

"Why didn't you warn me?" the man yelled up at the painter.

"I did," the painter replied. "I yelled 'Quack, quack, gobble, gobble.'"

"What does that mean?" the man hollered angrily. "Duck, turkey!"

In such moments, we would all prefer a little more clarity, would we not? I remember a teacher I had in college one time – a guy I had a lot of respect for – a brilliant man – and also a very kind and caring person. He was a professor and also a preacher in a mainline denomination. However, when I heard him preach, it was well-nigh impossible to understand what he meant. He used such dense vocabulary, and such intricate and complex phrasing, that it would have taken great time and effort and analysis to discern what he said. He was not clear at all. No doubt what he said was important, but what he said was a mystery.

I have always tried in my efforts to be clear when I teach and when I preach. I am sure I have often failed. My conviction to try to communicate this way was taught me, and it was modeled before me, and I have understood God through His Word to call me to speak in this way.

This was Paul's way, for instance. Remember these words? "At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison-that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak" (Colossians 4:3-4).

My thought is, if Paul thought he ought to speak this way, so should I, and so should we. After all, we are communicating with a purpose: to teach people of God, and how to connect with God, and what their Creator wants from them. If we make it obscure or hard to follow, we defeat our purpose.

In other words, if you drop a paint brush from on high, yell "Look out below!" – turkey!

#### Intimidation

The definition of "intimidate" is "to make afraid." The root of the word is "timid." It can be easy for us to feel intimidated when we are in the presence of someone we perceive to be smarter or more talented than we are. We hesitate to state our opinion or try something new, for fear of sounding or looking foolish.

In stock car racing, Dale Earnhardt earned the nickname "The Intimidator" because of his great talent and aggressive driving. Because of his reputation, just the sight of his car approaching in their rearview mirror would cause some professional drivers to make nervous mistakes, and sometimes to just pull over and let him pass!

When sharing our faith, it can be easy for us to allow ourselves to be intimidated. We may feel that the person is so convicted about what they already believe that we will not be able to convince them of the truth. Or the person we are hoping to convert may be someone we are already intimidated by, because of their title, or position, or education, or whatever. Worse yet, when we realize the devil is behind all the sin and resistance we come up against, we may be tempted to just pull over and let him pass. After all, he has a few thousand years of experience in keeping people from God.

The good news is if we are teaching the truth of God's Word, even the devil cannot intimidate us. The truth is the devil is intimidated by the truth! The Word we are teaching is the same Word Jesus used to turn away the devil. We can teach the Scriptures to the most learned, talented, and high-ranking people in the world without fear, because the gospel is the power of God to salvation. Just as importantly, we can teach our friends and neighbors with confidence, because it is the Scriptures, not our own talent or knowledge, that will convince them of their need for God's grace.

Let us boldly proclaim the gospel of Christ to those with whom we have the opportunity.

"For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline." - 2 Timothy 1:7


