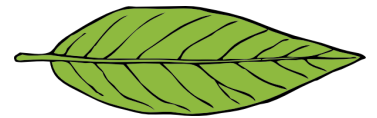

This week I ran across a story about a man who was directing a mission work to China. Candidates would go and teach English and do evangelism privately on the side. He would often interview those interested in making the trip. On one occasion, he met with a group of applicants to determine their motivations for service. "And why do you wish to go to China as a missionary?" he asked one. "I want to go because Christ has commanded us to go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature," was the reply. Another said, "I want to go because millions are perishing without Christ." Others gave different answers. I love his evaluation of all of the candidates. He said, "All of these motives, however good, will fail you in times of testings, trials, tribulations, and possible death. There is but one motive that will sustain you in trial and testing; namely, the love of Christ."

Is that not what should motivate all us, whether we feel compelled to go on a foreign mission trip or just to live our life to the glory of God? The NIV puts it this way in 2 Corinthians 5:14: "For Christ's love compels us."
