In 1 Samuel, the Israelites are at war with the Philistines. Why? Because years ago, when God charged them with conquering the land, they were afraid of the giants and so they would not go up against them. The Israelites directly made trouble for themselves in the future by disobeying God. The presence of the giants was not by a punishment that God sent upon them but through the consequences of their own foolish actions it came back on them.

The Philistine champion stands up to challenge the kingdom of Israel and Saul doesn't want to go out to meet him. This is understandable on a purely human level. Goliath was a good sized man, 9 feet 9 inches by our best understanding. He came from a clan of giants and carried a weapon fit for a giant. He cut an imposing figure to say the least.

But David trusted God and took on Goliath. He defeated the enemy that his ancestors and his king feared. He rose to the challenge in a way that showed not only his own strength but the faith he had in God.

Jesus challenged the faith of his apostles when they were asking for help casting out demons. He told them why they failed: "Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

That faith has very little to do with the abilities of the apostles to move that mountain. David's faith in God had very little to do with his rock-slinging arm. Our challenge today is to step out in faith to take on battles we can't win, because God will win them.
