

When God appeared to Moses in the wilderness near Mt. Sinai at the bush which was burning but would not burn up, Moses asked for His name so that he could tell people who had sent him. God revealed that His name was "I Am Who I AM" and tells him to tell the people that "I AM" sent him (Exodus 3: 14).

The original Hebrew alphabet was made up of only consonants and so the noun from the verb "I am" was YHWH. Later scribes, the Masoretes, added the vowels—dots and dashes—to the Hebrew Bible. Because that took the Ten Commandments very seriously, they interpreted the commandment not to take God's name in vain to mean don't even say God's name. When they copied God's

name, they simply added the vowels for the word Lord, Adonai, to "I Am" and would simply say Lord.

The American Standard Version followed the German pattern and made the Y a J and the W a V and inserted vowels. They arrived at Jehovah for God's name which we still see in many of our songs today. It is a series of letters which cannot be in Hebrew. Most English translations follow the pattern of the Masoretes and simply render God's name as Lord, Lord with all capital letters. It is more likely Yahweh.

The significance of God's name is that He is the one who was and is and always will be. We worship a God who is eternal.
