Someone remarked recently that the Sweetheart's Luncheon as a kickoff for our widowhood ministry on Tuesday, 2/15, at 11 a.m. sounded *depressing*. This highlights the public relations battle that the widowed have in society ... and sadly in the church to not feel further isolated.

It's understandable why this one loss is misunderstood as it's so unique and exclusive. Many have experienced the loss of a family member, friend, or pet, and no such loss should be minimized. We struggle to cope after all losses. The flip side of great love is great grief!

But the loss of a spouse is different. You dated and fell in love with this person. You married and perhaps raised kids with your husband or wife. Your spouse was more than a loved one or best friend. It's the only relationship God gave mankind because something was not good in His creation ... and in which two become one:

"Then the Lord God said, 'It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him.' ... Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh" Genesis 2:18 ... 24.

And so, when death rips a spouse away at any age, the survivor is a bleeding half, lost in a world he or she has not navigated alone, often for many decades. The widowed among us need to talk, to share, to be understood ... but far too often they are isolated. And we are many.

There are about 23 who attend 36th Street and a dozen more connected to members who are invited to the luncheon, where they will each bring a picture of their sweetheart and share with others eager to hear in the Widows' Walk ministry all about their *one* they once built a life with.

Depressing? Not at all! Invigorating, perhaps. And alone no longer.
