There's nothing worse than hearing the buzzing of a mosquito seconds after turning off your bedside lamp. You flip on the light and watch for movement, clapping your hands together and miss it. It wings away until it disappears ... but you know it's there. Greatly annoyed, you can't sleep until you end its life—which isn't so great for the mosquito.

This is how the Lord's church ought to greatly annoy the world with the gospel, and yet, so often it would rather blend in with every other group or business so much that it's the world that sleeps contentedly while we hide in the corner and reminisce about times past when we really used to buzz in its ears and avoid its swats. Perhaps we even pray and sing about standing out because of truth, but we don't dare venture near the hands that may squish us.

The 1st century church had no such qualms. Peter and John had just healed a man who had been lame since birth, and an "utterly astounded" crowd had run to them to see this new thing that had been done. Not all were impressed, however. The temple leaders descended on them, "greatly annoyed because they were teaching the people and proclaiming in Jesus the resurrection from the dead." This would not be the first nor the last time the world of that generation would try to squash the mosquito.

The scourge (what a great collective word for mosquitos) refused to stop buzzing with the gospel, however, and the situation ended with all that the world had the power to do (further threats) and the mosquitoes' persistence of "we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard" ... which continued to greatly annoy the world.

Does this attitude characterize today's mosquitoes? Do believers today pray for boldness in our buzzing or a ceasing of the world's swats? Do we love our lives too much in a world we don't wish to annoy and so don't buzz in its ears? Not wanting to offend with the truth, do we remain silent?
