Remember Your Leaders

Celebrities and influencers are important in our culture right now—not because they entertain us but because of their power to promote ideas and push agendas. It's not because they know a lot about anything. Actually, they often know very little. But, because of their popularity in an age where truth and facts are relative, their opinions are held up by many as standards to follow.

There was a time not too long ago when God's Word held that esteem, and those who preached or led people in His ways were held in high regard. Sadly, in our postmodern world, those anchors have been cut—even for many within the Lord's church.

Hebrews 13:7 tells us, "Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith." How powerful it is to look into the great cloud of witnesses that we've been blessed with for so many decades! And how essential the Holy Spirit tells us this is to helping us in our spiritual walk!

Throughout our 98.5-year history, we've had many speak the word of God to us during special events and weekly preaching from the pulpit. Some were connected with OVU, and many around the MOV and the world were brought to Christ because of them. One who served faithfully for a quarter of our century in Vienna is still a member with his wife. His father preached at what would become 36 th Street and around the valley before him.

Of the eighteen elders who have served here since 1946, seven are still members here, and three are serving still, the oldest since 1985. Another is the son of an elder who served decades ago. One of the seven is our oldest member at age 95 and was an elder when his company built the 36 th Street facility in 1972—50 years ago this year.

What a blessing to have such leaders among us to remember, to consider the outcome of their lives, and to imitate their faith! They are the real celebrities and influencers.
