You Shall Not Fear

In the 1939 classic, "The Wizard of Oz," based on Frank L Baum's 1900 book, Dorothy, the Scarecrow, and the Tinman go through the Haunted Forest reciting the now famous line, "Lions, and tigers, and bears—oh my!" to help them through their fear.

Fear can be crippling. As the oldest child, I had to take out our food garbage to a compost heap at the end of our backyard at the edge of a dark woods. To help me through that fear, I recited Psalm 23: "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil" Believing God was with me helped me push past my fear to do what I had to do.

By the time of Gideon in the book of Judges, the people had so drifted from God, who had saved them with Moses through the Red Sea and sustained them for forty years in the wilderness, that they attributed the bad things that were happening to them as God's absence from His people rather than their own sins. A prophet reminded them, "And I said to you, 'I am the LORD your God; you shall not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.' But you have not obeyed my voice."

Many years before, when they first entered the Promised Land, God promised to be with them so they could take the land ... and they were told not to fear. Fear made them shrink back, and so God's people faced problems. Their lack of courage led to disobedience.

Is this the church today? We've confined our faith to the walls of our buildings and only with trepidation do we venture out into the hostile culture while steeling our nerves with a chant of "lions, and tigers, and bears—oh my!" Could it be that our struggles are a result of our fear leading to disobedience? Like them, Jesus has promised us He'll be with us to the very end of the age.

Do we have the courage to "Go and make disciples ..."?
