# What If ... by Doug Kashorek

What if the great persecution that broke out against the Lord's church wasn't in the first century but the 21st? And what if instead of Jerusalem, members of His body that were gathered altogether in our major cities were scattered throughout the country? And what if instead of knowing each other for decades, we, coming from all over, were finding each other for the first time and were delighted to discover fellow Christians who had all fled to the MOV?

What would we do? Not having any other churches of Christ here and OVU never having existed, we'd be true spiritual pioneers. In the absence of church buildings and denominations and the same persecution not having reached here yet, we might look for a suitable place to meet—perhaps in an abandoned school building as it has plenty of classroom space and a large multi-purpose room in which we could worship and hold other functions.

Would we conduct our Christian walk as we are currently doing? Starting over, how long would we survive if we just showed up 1-3 times per week to hear God's Word and commented occasionally on the Facebook members' page to encourage someone? As numbers began to dwindle, would we blame the preacher for not presenting the right lessons or leaders for not implementing the right ministries to capture the hearts of the lost around us?

What works? Well, in the 1st century, incredible growth occurred because when a great persecution scattered Christians, they preached the gospel wherever they went. Not just the preacher or leaders—all of them!

What if the persecution we face has made us blend in with the culture to not be noticed? What if the culture is loud with competing doctrines and ideas and keeps us busy and distracted with other things? What if the gospel is only heard at compartmentalized times from a few that we've selected to preach it?

**But,** what if we have the incredible facility we do, with all the resources we have, with the knowledgeable brothers and sisters that God has brought together? What if ...
