#### **Take Refuge in My Shade**

Abimelech was bad news from the start. The jealous and ambitious son of Gideon's concubine, he got into the hearts of the people that were already corrupted by the worship of Baal to be their leader. After they'd justified this bad idea by saying, "He is our brother," he killed all seventy of his half-brothers from his father's wives. He was, after all, a bramble.

Gideon's youngest son who somehow survived said so of him: "And the bramble said to the trees, 'If in good faith you are anointing me king over you, then come and take refuge in my shade'" Judges 9:15. This bramble was probably common buckthorn that has sharp, spike-like thorns at the tips of twigs, is poisonous and produces nothing of value, can grow 10-25 feet tall, and is a menace to farming in that region.

It was an apt description for Abimelech ... and for anything of the world that a Christian might become involved with. 2 Corinthians 6:14-15 says, "Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever?" We are to be God's people, separate from the world, in it but not of it.

Yet, so often followers of Christ take refuge in the world's shade. We sing "This World Is Not My Home" and then race to the mall to catch the latest sales. We kill our influence for the gospel by arguing politics on social media. We seek out governmental programs to be our Savior while printing on our money 'IN GOD WE TRUST.' If cultural Christians, our hearts too are corrupted by society's Baals. What will be the outcome?

Instead, Christ wore a crown of thorns for us so we wouldn't have to. As Galatians 3:13 explains, "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, 'Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree.'" That's the shade in which we take refuge.
