It's Not Even Fair!

This is what the Israelite army that had been quaking in fear every day since the warrior giant had been shouting his defiant challenges across the valley must have said. Perhaps King Saul had at least thought it as his war with the Philistines had stalled out because he lacked a champion. Then came this young shepherd, indignant for God and spouting nonsense about having taken on a lion and a bear to save his father's sheep, who said he'd take on Goliath.

Saul offered his own armor, but the kid refused it. Instead, he approached the nine-foot behemoth, who wore 125 pounds of scale armor and wielded a fifteen-pound tipped spear the size of a tree ... with only five smooth stones from a brook.

No, it wasn't fair, not fair at all ... for Goliath! For, you see, it wasn't the handful of rocks that the world saw that mattered at all. Why? Because all of God's foolishness and weakness said to the giant, "You come to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin, but I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied."

Nor was it even fair for the combined might of the synagogue of the Freedman, Cyrenians, Alexandrians, and those from Cilicia and Asia who "could not withstand the wisdom and the Spirit" by which Stephen "full of grace and power" was speaking in Acts 6. Enraged, all they could do was gnash their teeth at him and stone him ... which just brought him into "gain" (Philippians 1:21). It's not fair that the world is so powerless before God!

Nor is it fair for the world that contends with those who know Christ as the power of God and the wisdom of God. Thus, 1 Corinthians 1 continues, *"For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men."* We can stand strong against the world's giants and the culture's corrupt synagogues because ... it's not even fair!
