A day or so later, this message came from Gerald's nephew, Lori's cousin: *Doug, just want to thank you so much for all you've done for our family and yes you will always be a part of it (including your wonderful wife)! So ... because Lori chose me and I remained faithful to her 'til death did we part, I am a part of the family, but not only me—Angie is now part of the family though she had only just met them! All because one had died.*

In a similar way, I am part of the Newberry family—because Joe had died. Today, we are on our 1st Anniversary (that's right, it's been one year since we were married) trip to Texas to visit our family, made possible because Angie's husband died! We now have four sides of our physical family.

But there is a fifth—because One has died for all of us. When we got to the North Country, our brothers and sisters in Christ there were eager to meet Angie and had prepared a meal for us. The love of Christ was immediately present because she had been part of the family for over three decades although they had never met. This is how it is wherever someone who has obeyed the gospel encounters the church because we are "*born of water and the Spirit*" John 3:5.

As the song says: *We're part of the fam'ly that's been born again; Part of the fam'ly whose love knows no end; For Jesus has saved us, and made us His own, Now we're part of the fam'ly that's on its way home.* Are you part of the family?
