This month, we need your family trees that highlight the multiple generations of your family who worshiped here.

Soon after the new year begins, we'll be asking for your help in inviting everyone you know to attend our many events throughout that month and our <u>Centennial Banquet</u>, which will be held at Grand Pointe on May 25, 2024—an exact century after the church's dedication. Our quilters will have a special <u>Centennial Quilt</u> done by then to go with the many artifacts we're displaying in our cabinet. We plan to have many preachers from the past speak of 36th Streets role over the past century through the Parable of the Sower from Matthew 13.
