Holy Spirit or Super Power?

We love superheroes and their powers! Marvel and DC Comics' creations have leapt and flown from the pages of comic books to the big screen with CGI capabilities. Many today probably know the name of Stan Lee more than Samson in today's culture. And, so it's no wonder that so many Christians, who struggle not to be products of the culture, see the Holy Spirit as a superpower that God gives a few lucky individuals—like the Hulk's incredible strength or Batman's prowess to vanquish many enemies.

Isn't that what we see Samson doing? Judges 14:19 says, "And the Spirit of the LORD rushed upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon and struck down thirty men of the town and took their spoil and gave the garments to those who had told the riddle." Really? Murder. Stealing. Paying off a gambling debt. That's what the Holy Spirit is all about? Actually ... not at all like a mantle that just enhances the character traits of the bearer while giving him extraordinary powers, many see God's Spirit today as possessing a person and taking away any control over his own actions.

The Spirit, however, is the third person of the one God, who acts independently and in complete unity with the Father and the Son. He acts with His own purpose. With Bezalel and Oholiab, the Spirit gave great skill to craft the tabernacle and all its furnishings. Upon Jesus, it revealed Him to be God's own Son. But, how about Saul, who had the Spirit come upon him so that he prophesied when he was seeking David's life? Or Samson, whose immoral character sought what pleased self rather than God? Did God condone their behavior? Or worse ... make them do these things?

No, the dollops of the Spirit in the Old Testament have given way today to God pouring out Himself into those who are His own. When? As a gift when we are baptized into Jesus for the forgiveness of our sins (Acts 2:36-38). That's when the Spirit rushed upon you. What are you doing with it?



Many of you have asked what happened to Linda recently. Two weeks ago, God woke me up at 4AM. I never wake up at that hour. I looked at Linda and something seemed wrong. I tried to wake her up, but she was unresponsive. I immediately called an ambulance. They took her to Camden Clark. The doctors inserted a ventilator and she was sedated. That night, the doctors decided to do a procedure at Ruby in Morgantown and she was transported by helicopter to Ruby. Doctors used a balloon to open a valve in her heart that was causing all the problems. Excess fluid around her lungs had collapsed a lung. After a 2 week stay, she was sent home where she is getting ready for a permanent valve replacement on October 10th. It was later, we were told by doctors, that Linda, at one point, had only 5 minutes to live. We both want to express our deepest thanks for all your prayers, cards, visits and food. Your prayers to God have been heard and Linda is showing a rapid recovery. Thanks again to all of you.
