The Picture on the Box

Anyone who has ever put a difficult puzzle together is grateful for the picture on the box. Holding a certain piece up to that picture, she may turn it until she sees colors or a pattern that matches a spot on the box. But ... if she didn't have the box?

Life is like that—except that we and the experiences that we go through are the puzzle pieces. But we don't have to put the puzzle together. We just need to trust the One who is able to do it. Hindsight is certainly 20/20, and as we study God's Word, we can see how He was putting all the pieces of the puzzle together for His purpose.

Acts 11:26 is a verse most of us know: "... And in Antioch the disciples were first called Christians." But this is really the picture on the box. What were the individual pieces of the puzzle that had to come together for the picture to be seen?

One is the persecution of disciples that scattered them all over the known world, who trusted that God was working all things out for their good. Rather than growing frightened or discouraged, they preached the Word wherever they went.

Another was the conversion of the church's great persecutor, Saul, who was introduced to the those he had persecuted by "the son of encouragement," originally from Cyrene. "Barnabas" was later dispatched to Antioch by these same disciples.

A third was the keys to the kingdom that Peter used to open the church to gentile believers. Some who had been scattered by the persecution who were from Cyrene preached the gospel to the gentiles in Antioch, and these former pagans who knew nothing of God or His Word began flooding the church there in droves. So, Barnabas found the former persecutor of many there and together they taught the truth about Jesus.

And so, Jewish disciples were rebranded with gentile believers as "Christians." Maybe, when life isn't going how we'd like it to go, we can trust the One who can see the picture on the box!
