God's Remnant to Preserve Life

What terrible circumstances brought Joseph here! Sold by his brothers into slavery in Egypt, falsely accused of sexual misconduct by the wife of his master (Pharoah's executioner?), and then forgotten in prison for two years by Pharoah's cupbearer, Joseph certainly had cause to complain about his circumstances. But, when faced with the power and opportunity for revenge, Joseph saw that he was God's to be used for His great purpose, saying, "And God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant on earth, and to keep alive for you many survivors" Genesis 45:7.

God has always preserved remnants. From the eight on the ark, who were saved from death in the flood, He preserved a remnant. With the covenant He made with Israel on Mount Sinai, God took a remnant from all peoples. Through Ezra and Nehemiah, He preserved a remnant of those returning from captivity in Babylon who were willing to restore right worship and living. And now through His Son and His work of the gospel, God is once again preserving a remnant who will obey His gospel and live faithfully before Him.

Being part of a remnant means that you are being given a second chance. When Solomon turned away from God later in his life, God said to Jeroboam before Rehoboam ever unwisely followed the counsel of the young men who had grown up with him, "Behold, I am about to tear the kingdom from the hand of Solomon and will give you ten tribes." Jeroboam had to be faithful, though, as God added this, "And if you will listen to all that I command you, and will walk in my ways, and do what is right in my eyes by keeping my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did, I will be with you and will build you a sure house, as I built for David, and I will give Israel to you" 1 Kings 11:38.

Jeroboam, of course, did not, but do we with the second chance that Jesus gives us, His remnant? Are we willing to be used by Him?


