You Give Love a Bad Name

Did Samson love? Was it love when he "saw one of the daughters of the Philistines" and demanded his father, "Now get her for me as my wife"? Was it love when he finally told her the answer to his riddle because she wore him down by weeping for seven days of their wedding feast and he called her a heifer? Was it love when he "saw a prostitute, and he went in to her"?

No, in both cases, it seems that one who should be God's took what his eyes desired. Eve did this: "So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes ..." Genesis 3:6. This is not love but love for the world. 1 John 2:15-16 further defines this sin, "Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world."

So, when the Delilah story begins with "after this he loved a woman ...," we suspect that it's a worldly love or lust that was this strong man's weakness. Scripture defines love: "In this is love, not that we loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins" 1John 4:10. This sacrificial standard for love is set by Jesus as in Ephesians 5:25 we're commanded, "Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her." Any attempt to redefine this biblical term in worldly ways is a lie.

This includes any sexual relationship outside of God's definition for marriage (Genesis 2:24) that the world wants to attach to the word *love*—and Samson hits a few! When those who are God's people love in worldly ways, Bon Jovi's song from the 80's is true of us, "... you give love a bad name."
