

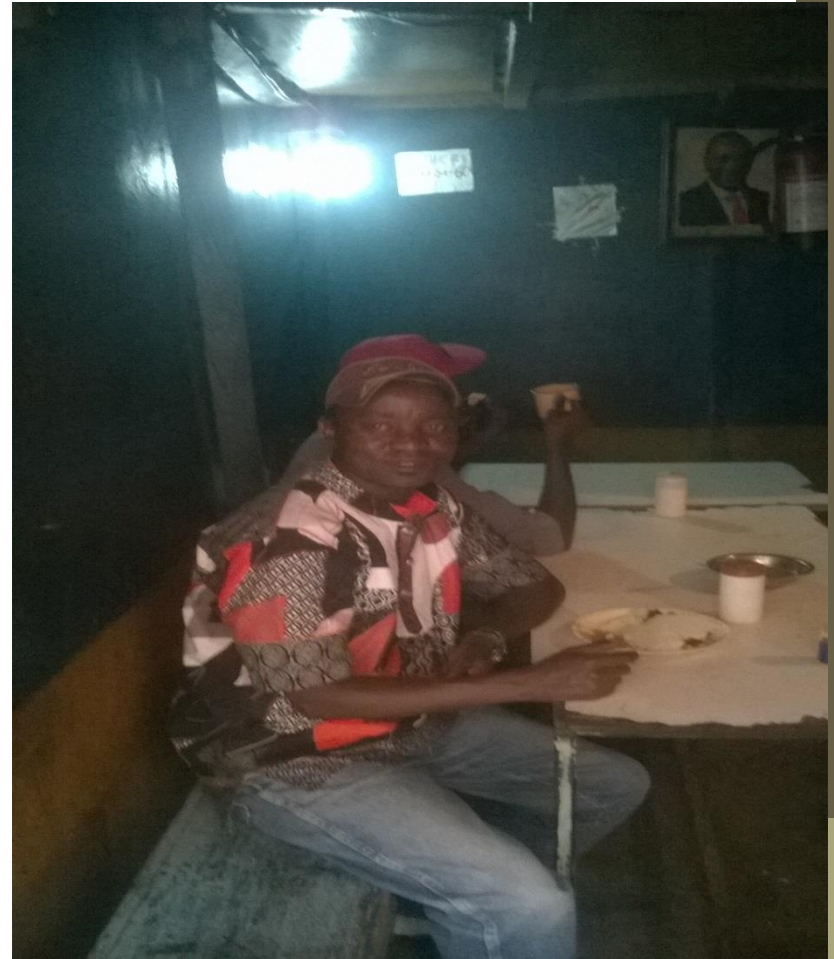
# Two Days In The City

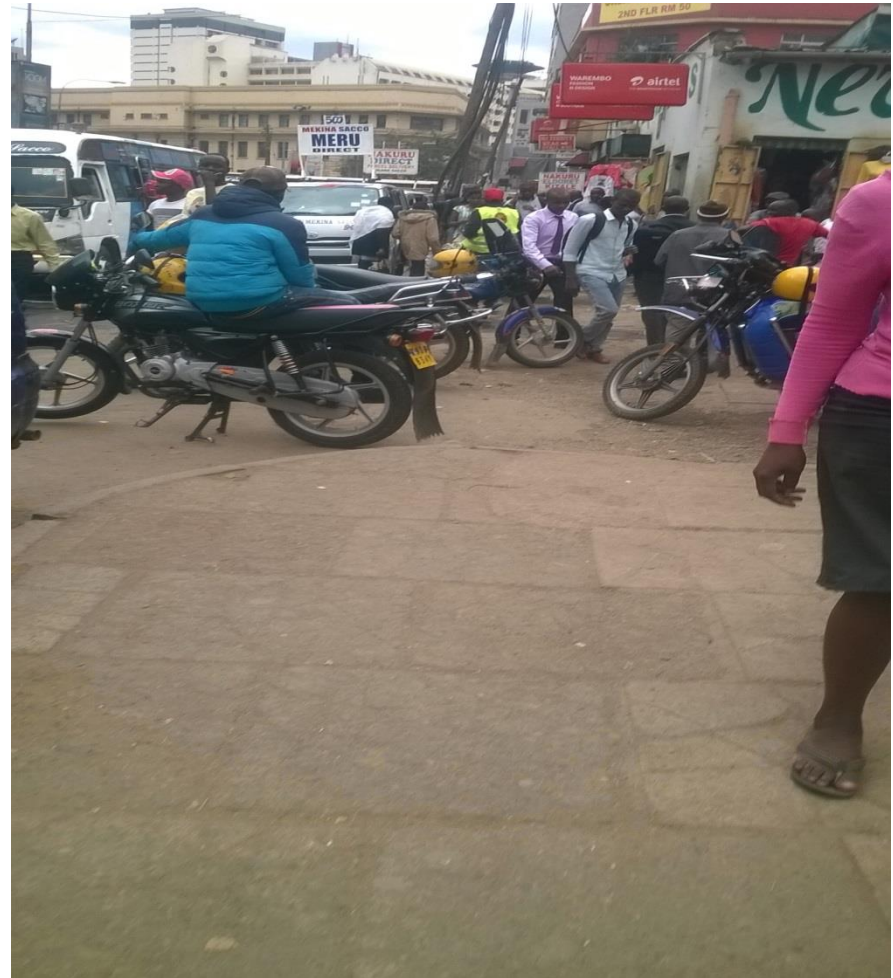

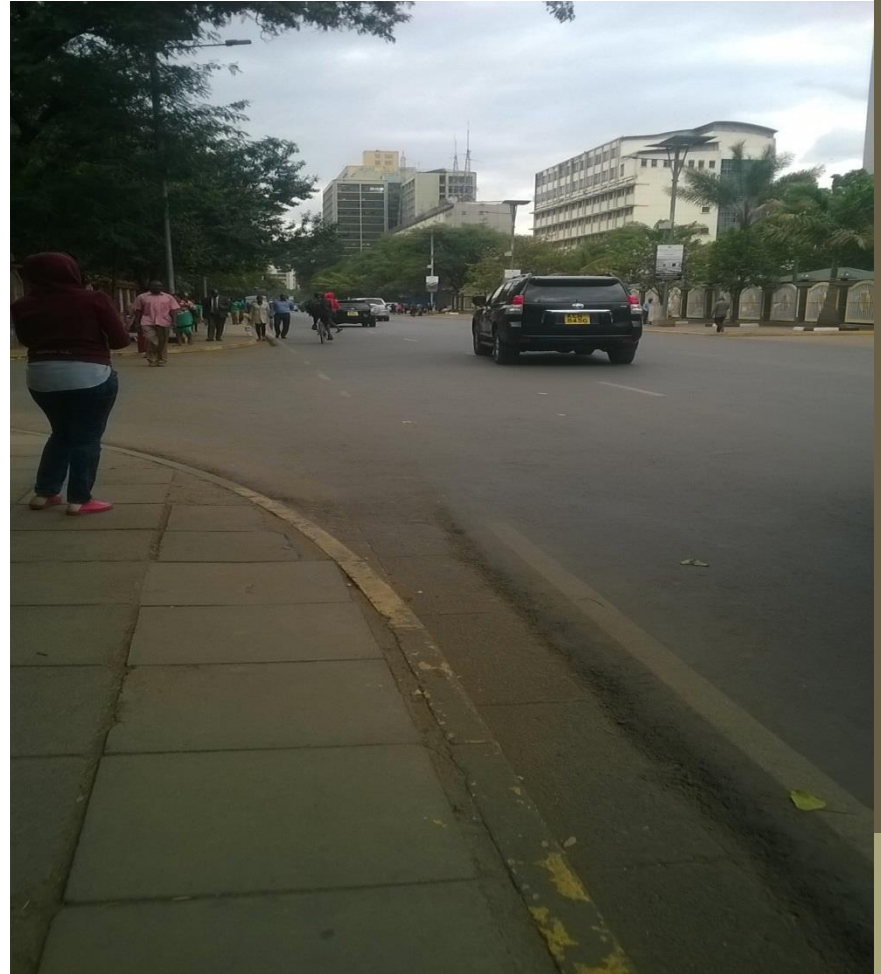
